



Privacy Policy

Hunter Corp Limited, a company incorporated in Hong Kong with registered address Suite 1103B, 11/F, Join-In Hang Sing Centre, 2-16 Kwai Fung Crescent, Kwai Chung, N.T, Hong Kong and its affiliates (collectively referred to as "HCL", "we", "our" or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and share the personal information we collect from visitors to our website including our mobile applications (this "Website").

"You" and "your" when used in this Privacy Policy includes any person who accesses this Website and submits personal information.

By accessing or using any of our services and/or the Website or by downloading, installing or using our mobile application, you signify that you have read, understood and agree to our collection, storage, use and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy.

1 Collection of Personal Information

1.1 We may collect, store and use the following kinds of personal information (your "Personal Information"):

1.1.1 information about your computer and about your visits to and use of this Website, such as your IP address, geographical location, browser type, referral source, length of visit and number of page views;

1.1.2 information that you provide to us for the purpose of registering with us (including your name, date of birth, identify reference, occupation, email address, telephone number, postal address, and company details);

1.1.3 information relating to any transactions carried out between you and us on or in relation to this Website including information relating to any purchases you make;

1.1.4 information that you provide to us for the purpose of subscribing to our Website services, email notifications and/or newsletters; and

1.1.5 any other information that you choose to send to us.

1.2 When you connect to any service we offer and/or the Website with services offered by third-parties, such as by "Liking" us on Facebook or following us on Twitter, or when you link any service we offer and/or the Website with

other services, this may include your Personal Information being transferred, and you hereby permit such transfers. The data we receive is dependent upon your privacy settings with the third-party. You should always review, and if necessary, adjust your privacy settings on third-party websites and services before linking or connecting them to any service we offer and/or the Website.

- 1.3 Your Personal Information may be retained as long as it remains pertinent to the purpose for collection. Once no longer relevant, your Personal Information will be destroyed by secure means, whether on paper or in electronic format.

2 Cookies

- 2.1 We use cookies on this Website. A cookie consists of information sent by a web server to a web browser and stored by the browser. The information is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. This enables the web server to identify and track the web browser. We may send you cookies which may be stored on by your browser on your computer's hard drive. We may use the information we obtain from the cookies in the administration of this Website, to improve the Website's usability and for marketing purposes. We may also use that information to recognise your computer when you visit our Website, and to personalise our Website for you. Most browsers allow you to refuse to accept cookies, however this will have a negative impact upon the usability of many websites, including our Website. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to our Website is used to create reports about the use of the Website. Google will store this information. 3 Using your Personal Information

- 3.1 Your Personal Information submitted on this Website will be used for the purposes specified in this privacy policy or in relevant parts of the Website. We may use your personal information to:
 - 3.1.1 administer the Website;
 - 3.1.2 improve your browsing experience by personalising the Website;
 - 3.1.3 enable your use of the services available on the Website;
 - 3.1.4 send to you downloads purchased via the Website;
 - 3.1.5 send statements and invoices to you, and collect payments from you;

- 3.1.6 send to you general (non-marketing) commercial communications;
- 3.1.7 send to you email notifications which you have specifically requested;
- 3.1.8 send to you our newsletter and other marketing communications (relating to our business which we think may be of interest to you) by post or, where you have specifically agreed to this, by email or similar technology;
- 3.1.9 provide third parties with statistical information about our users but only provided that this information will not be used to identify any individual user; and
- 3.1.10 deal with enquiries and complaints made by or about you relating to our Website.

3.2 We cannot accept any liability for processing of your Personal Information by a third party outside our remit.

4 Permitted disclosures

4.1 In addition to the disclosures reasonably necessary for the purposes identified elsewhere in this Privacy Policy, we may disclose your Personal Information:

- 4.1.1 to the extent that we are required to do so by law;
- 4.1.2 in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings;
- 4.1.3 in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk); and
- 4.1.4 to the purchaser (or prospective purchaser) of any business or asset which we are (or are contemplating) selling.

5 International data transfers

5.1 Your Personal Information that we collect may be stored and processed in, and transferred between, any of the countries in which we operate in order to enable us to use your Personal Information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Security of your Personal Information is very important to us. All feasible security measures are in place, particularly when transferring data between countries.

5.2 If you are in the European Union, your Personal Information which you provide may be transferred to countries which do not have data protection laws equivalent to those in force in the European Union. You expressly agree to such transfers.

6 Data Security

We will take reasonable technical and organisational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your Personal Information. We will store all your Personal Information on our secure servers, however, data transmission over the internet is inherently insecure, and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet. You are responsible for keeping your password and user details confidential for accessing any of our services or this Website. We will never ask you for your password. In the event that any information under our control is compromised as a result of a breach of security, we will take reasonable steps to investigate the situation and to notify you if the security, integrity or confidentiality of your Personal Information has been compromised, in accordance with any applicable laws and regulations.

7 Your rights

- 7.1 You may instruct us to provide you with any Personal Information we hold about you and we have one month in which to supply this information to you.
- 7.2 You may request that we amend or delete any of your Personal Information and we have one month in which to amend or delete such Personal Information for you.
- 7.3 You may instruct us not to process your Personal Information for marketing purposes by email at any time.
- 7.4 You may choose not to have a unique web analytics cookie identification number assigned to your computer to avoid the aggregation and analysis of data collected on this Website. To make that choice, please click below to receive an opt-out cookie.

8 Children's privacy

We do not knowingly solicit or collect personal information from children under the age of 16 unless it was provided with the assistance and under the supervision of a person holding parental responsibility. If we learn that any personal information has been collected from a child under 16 without the assistance and under the supervision of a person holding parental responsibility, we will delete the information as soon as possible upon learning or receiving written notification about this.
